Battery-Powered Streetcars

- Alstom: Per previous correspondence, they have agreed to present to the City. We are arranging a coordination call with them the week of November 18th to review the City's requirements and the parameters of their presentation.
- TIG/m: Per previous correspondence, they have agreed to present to the City. We are arranging a coordination call with them the week of November 18th to review the City's requirements and the parameters of their presentation.

Trackless Streetcars

- BYD: BYD has agreed to present on December 2nd. After explaining the trackless streetcar concept to them, they believe they will be able to present how they may be able to provide the City with a comparable solution.
- Van Hool: Per previous correspondence, they have agreed to present to the City. We are arranging a coordination call with them the week of November 18th to review the City's requirements and the parameters of their presentation.
- CRRC: We have attempted contact CRRC through multiple channels; at this point, we will proceed without them, as there is no evidence their product is moving forward in the North American market.

Next Steps

We will set up follow-up discussions with each of the vendors the week of November 18th to • confirm that their presentations are providing the information requested by the City. In the interest of adhering to the 15-minute time limit, we may ask them to provide leave-behinds that cover the technical aspects of their solution so there is more time to discuss their technologies and their applications to the City.
