Hi, Rudy and Ted. It was great connecting again and visiting Anaheim first hand. There is great potential for a new kind of transit system.

Attached is our proposal for an initial scope of work that can get things moving. This will get you into position for a larger proposal to ATID to dig deeper, similar to the process Irvine has taken.

We are preparing some more information about grants whose goals and timelines match Anaheim's process, and we will get that to you next week. To your other question about using a parking garage as a maintenance facility, while we can't get a full pod + trolley + guideway into the 8.5' level, we do see ways to design an interface where pods can be separated from the trolleys for their maintenance work, and the trolleys + rail can then be handled separately, all within the 8.5' clearance in a typical garage deck.

Let us know your thoughts on the attached.
