Ada Briceno, noted newcomer to the 67th District, is being promoted to voters by a vocal and active Trump donor – one who was named a top-ten donor to the 2020 presidential campaign.

The pro-Briceno campaign is funded by the Hawaiian Gardens Casino, owned by the Moskowitz family. The paterfamilias, Irving Moskowitz, is what is known as "controversial" in polite circles for his financial support -funded by the bingo hall at their casino – of right-wing movements in the middle east. Cherna Moskowitz gave to nearly 200 Republican candidates, PACs, and state parties in 2020 alone, per FEC records. The \$4.8M+ figure covers only confirmed disclosures to Trump-affiliated committees and does not include smaller-dollar giving to individual House members (Nunes, Crenshaw, etc.) or state Republican parties.
